Bellamy Printz graduated from Macalaster College in St. Paul, MN with a BA in English and from the Art Institute of Chicago where she received a BFA. She received her MFA from University of Washington in Seattle in 1996. She moved to Cleveland in 1996 after graduating to pursue her art career. She where she helped establish Zygote Press, a non-profit, fine art printmaking collaborative. In addition to her work at Zygote, Bellamy is an independent curator, teacher, consultant and grant writer. Curated exhibitions include, "Fabricating Memory," with William Busta, and "Retro-Virus" with John Chaich in 2000 in Cleveland. Currently she is co-curating an exhibition for Zygote Press and the Ohio Arts Council titled "Foreign Affairs," an exhibition at Cleveland State University, scheduled for January 2004 which will travel to Otterbein College in April. The latter exhibition is a retrospective of the Dresden Residency Program, supported by the Ohio Arts Council, which Bellamy has coordinated for the past six years at Zygote Press. She has given printmaking workshops nationally, and has exhibited her work locally and nationally, including the Cleveland Center for Contemporary Art (MOCA) and the Southern Ohio Art Museum. She is the recipient of an Ohio Arts Council independent Artist Fellowship and an Artist Project Grant. Bellamy lives in Cleveland by Lake Erie with her family which consists of a husband, twin toddlers and a dog.
