

Kay Koeninger is an Associate Professor of Art at Sinclair Community College in Dayton. She teaches a wide range of art history courses, including American and modern art history. Before coming to Sinclair, she was Curator of Collections at the Galleries of the Claremont Colleges in Claremont, California; Director of the Denison University Art Gallery in Granville; an art reviewer for the *Columbus Dispatch*; and Director of the Dayton Visual Arts Center. She has taught at Denison University, Wright State University and Antioch College, and was an affiliated scholar at Kenyon College. She received her B.A. cum laude with high honors in History from Kenyon College, her M.A. in History from Eastern Washington University and her M.A. in Art History from the University of California, Riverside. She has curated numerous exhibitions and written catalog essays in Native American art; 19th and early 20th century American art; American ceramics; and contemporary American art.
